Request for Bid to Review Environmental Health Laws and Regulations

FSM Department of Health and Social Affairs January 10, 2012

1. General Scope of Work

The Department of Health and Social Affairs (HSA) of the FSM National Government (*hereinafter referred as "government"*) hereby solicits bid from interested individual (*hereinafter referred as "applicants"*) to assist the HSA and the FSM States in reviewing existing laws, regulation, and other relevant documents. The scope of work includes the following:

- Consult with relevant stakeholders at the FSM National level and FSM State level in the reviewing and drafting process;
- Assess current situations of environmental health and sanitation in the FSM;
- Distinguish roles of the FSM National Government and the FSM State governments in the enforcement of environmental health and sanitation laws and regulations;
- Review existing legislations and regulations for the FSM National Government and FSM State governments; and
- Draft regulations, policy or legislations to protect public health from diseases and poor sanitation.

The applicant may have to travel to all the FSM States to collect the relevant data or documents to review. The final scope of work will be reviewed and approved by HAS.

2. Eligibility

Applicant must be a graduate of a law school and must be familiar with the FSM National Government and the FSM States legal systems. Prior working experience in law in the FSM will be a plus.

3. Registration of Expression of Interest

Applicant may express interest by emailing a brief (no more than 2 pages) proposal to the Secretary of the Department of Health and Social Affairs, Dr Vita A Skilling, at health@fsmhealth.fm. Such proposal must include the following:
