## DUTIES (ILLUSTRATIVE ONLY):

Coordinate sampling of all commercial fishing vessels unloads, transshipments and inspection in FSM port; Liaise with all FSM based fishing companies on providing all tuna export information to NORMA; Ensure all port sampling data is processed and entered into the NORMA database effectively; provide all port sampling and observer data to Secretariat of the Pacific Community-Oceanic Fisheries Program for further analysis and transshipment activities in relations to (WCPFCP), (CMM), (PNA and the (FFA); collect and compile transshipment data in FSM and foreign ports for FSM flag vessels; compile port sampling reports and report to the Executive Director on quarterly basis; assist in coordinating the National Observer Program including observer placements, verification of observer workbooks/reports, training manifestos from licensed fishing vessels in accordance with relevant national law and regulations; performs other duties as assigned.

## QUALIFICATION REQUIRMENTS:

Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree in Business Administration, Fisheries or related field plus three years of work experience in fisheries or other natural resources experience. Certify as an observer and experience with transshipment and port inspection duties.
